### Unique needs

Infants and children who present with IBD from a very young age (younger than 5 years old) can have distinct and, at times, more severe symptoms and manifestations of IBD compared to older children and adults with IBD. Furthermore, many of these children do not respond to conventional IBD therapy. Therefore, children with VEO-IBD require specialized evaluation and, in many cases, targeted treatments. Our research team works collaboratively to identify the underlying genetic and immunologic causes of VEO-IBD with the goal of personalizing care for each of our patients.

Our research has translated to individualized therapies for many of our patients and has led to the development of the CHOP VEO-IBD genetic sequencing panel made up of 98 genes. This panel is a clinically available, comprehensive test of genes involved in VEO-IBD and has met the highest regulatory standards that apply to all clinical laboratory testing in the United States.
